Effectively manage the pre-execution safety planning including: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Risk Assessment & SIMOP Assessment for all works during the execution phase.• Review & Sign-off of all work packs.• Prepare and manage the induction process & safety leadership training.• Manage all training requirements and assessment of competencies.• Ensure all safety aspects are identified and control measures are in place. Effectively manage the safety aspects of the execution phase. <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Responsible for safety management on site during this phase including proactive injury management.• Day & night shift safety coverage for all activities.• Management of medical centre & first line emergency response.

OUTCOMES
