## Description

The program is designed to provide individual with the knowledge and skills required to provide advanced resuscitation techniques, including airway management, oxygen resuscitation and using an Automated External Defibrillator.

## Course Content

### Theory

- The principles of first aid
- Basic OHS requirements
- Preparing resuscitation equipment for use
- Resuscitating techniques
- Attach and operate an Automated External Defibrillator (AED)
- Administer oxygen

- Operate suction equipment
- Restore and maintain resuscitation equipment

### Practical

- Perform simulated CPR for 2 minutes (Adult, child and baby)
- Use an AED (trainer model)
- Provide oxygen therapy and oxygen resuscitation to a patient during a minimum of two medical scenario's

## Prerequisites

There are no specific pre-requisites for this course. Learners must be over 18 years of age.

## Assessment

The theory assessment consists of multiple choice and short answer questions.

The practical assessment will require Learners to demonstrate the ability to assess the situation, apply first aid procedures including DRsABCD, prepare resuscitation equipment for use, attach and operate an AED, administer oxygen therapy and resuscitation equipment, use suction equipment, restore and maintain resuscitation equipment and communicate details of the incident.

## Language, Literacy and Numeracy

There are specific language, literacy and numeracy requirements for some of content of this course, to be deemed competent you must be able to:

- Read and correctly interpret required documentation relevant to the assessment and management of
- Speak clearly and unambiguously in English
- Explain, describe and verify sometimes complex needs and issues

Writing is required to the level of completing workplace forms and producing the required reports.

Numeracy is required to the level of being able to correctly differentiate between pressures and temperatures.
